## Safe Travel for Tipplers

King's Theatre is offering a "Safe Drive Home" option for its Robbie Burns Celebrations.

**January 14, 2019 – ANNAPOLIS ROYAL, NS:** King's Theatre's second annual Robbie Burns Night on January 25 has taken on new dimensions as the Theatre partners with Founders House Dining and Drinks and Cabbioke by NSLC, to guarantee guests a memorable celebration and a safe return home at the end of the evening.

NSLC representatives will be present at the event to distribute taxi chits in the amount of \$10 to attendees who need a safe drive home and require a cab. The participating cab company, Admiral's Taxi, will be ready to answer the calls.

King's is also facilitating a Designated Driver option. The full ticket price of \$60 has been cut to \$30, for those who will not be sampling the scotch. "We're thrilled to partner with NSLC to offer this Safe Drive Home initiative," said Event Organizer Flora Hall.

Tasting five samples of premium scotch is still high on the agenda for the event and, thanks to its partnership with Founders, the Theatre is able to offer a more elaborate menu this time out. It will also be expanding the number of available tickets to 100, as the Robbie Burns evening will be the very first shindig held at the new Event Room at the Fort View Golf Course.

"Last year's celebration was a huge success, but the size of our lobby really limited the number of tickets we could sell for the event," said Hall. "Everyone had such a good time last year so it's great that we can increase our numbers this time."

The mouthwatering menu, created by Founders Head Chef Chris Pyne, should go a long way in attracting that number. The traditional Haggis with "neeps and tatties" (turnips and potatoes) is guaranteed. In fact, it will be House-made. Chef Pyne is also planning a spectacular charcuterie selection and for dessert, a toothsome twist on a classic favourite. Great fiddling and piping and Robbie's "Address to a Haggis" will also add to the Celtic flavour of the night.

You can also purchase tickets to the main event.
